 **IMPORTANT:** Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately. NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC. Levels: Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

Regional Information

- 1) This trial is taking part in the 2018 NADAC Regional circuit.
- 2) This does not affect the actual running of the trial. The Regional scoring takes place alongside the normal weekend scoring for the Regular rounds.
- 3) All levels and classes that the club would normally have will still be offered, and everyone is welcome to come!
- 4) The regionals are also used as testing grounds for proposed ideas by our exhibitors. The two tests that will be run in 2018 are a team relay event and an updated version of Gamblers.
- 5) The test classes will be run at the very end of the day. No Q's are given as these are tests.
- 6) There is no entry fee for the test classes. The main goal of these tests is to see how experienced dog and handler teams navigate them, and what changes need to be made before the classes come out to the general public.
- 7) If the trial is fairly large we will be limiting the test runs to the Elite level, and a limited number of dogs to avoid adding multiple hours to the trial. If the trial is not completely full, then we will open up entries to the lower levels as well.
- 8) For more info on what the regional winners receive, scoring and updates on the test classes please check the NADAC website > Events > NADAC Regionals
- 9) Rules for the Gamblers and Team classes will be posted the morning of the show or sent with your confirmation. We promise they will be simple and easy to follow. These are tests and the rules are fluid as adjustments are made from regional to regional, hence the lack of posted rules until the trial date.
- 10) Entries for Gamblers and Team will be taken during the day of the trial.

Notice to Exhibitors:

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.

Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

→ All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of age are eligible to compete in NADAC Agility Trials. Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.

→ Any owner, handler, or spectator exhibiting poor sportsmanship or abuse towards a dog or person will be required to leave the show site for the duration of the trial.

→ Treats and toys will not be allowed within 10 feet of the ring, per NADAC rules.

→ All dogs must be on leash or securely crated when not in the ring.

→ Entries must be made on the enclosed entry forms. Copies may be made. **No other forms will be accepted.** Entries must be signed and be accompanied by the correct entry fees to be valid. Entry forms must be completely filled out and legible.

→ Dog sales or puppies under eight weeks old are not permitted on the trial site.

→ No catalogs will be printed. Running order lists will be printed and posted at the ring gate. Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as much as the class allows.

→ New Hope Agility Group, its board of directors, NADAC, management and the property owner assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, or children.

→ Day-to-Day move-ups WILL be allowed.

NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course. *When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.*

NEW: As of January-2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes

Jump Heights

Measurement forms may be obtained at <http://nadac.com/Application-for-Permanent-Height-Card.htm>

Dogs which require measuring:

- Dogs in the Proficient Category, Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16"

Dogs which do not need to be measured:

- Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division
- Dogs jumping 20"
- Dogs in the Skilled Category
- Dogs with a permanent NADAC height card
- Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

Jump Heights:

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", 20"

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16". Please see the NADAC Rulebook for the full jump height table.

Final run order will be included in e-mailed confirmations the week before the trial.

[Tunnelers and/or Touch N Go may be run as come-when-you-can.](#)

What is the Double Run Format? In the Double Run Format, both rounds run back-to-back on the exact same course, without re-walking. So, if you enter both rounds of a Double Run class, you will run within your class and then run again within your class for Round 2. You may also enter only Round 1 or Round 2, just like a regular format class.

→ Check-in will be only for those dogs who need to be measured. On Saturday & Sunday check-in will be from 7:15 to 7:45 am, with the first dog on the line at 8:00 am. ***Start times may be later based on entry. Make sure to read your confirmation*** All dogs, at all levels in Proficient, not jumping 20 must be measured. Dogs with permanent height cards from NADAC do not require measuring, nor do dogs entered in the Skilled category. Vet/JH dogs jumping 16" do not need to be measured. *Bring your height card with you, even if you mail a copy of it with your entries.*

→ **Directions to Louis Pearce: From Houston**-- Hwy 290 west to Hempstead. Turn RIGHT onto Hwy 6 North. Take the "Business 6" exit (Business 6 becomes Texas Ave.) in College Station. Turn LEFT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Parkway-- Wal Mart will be on the left). Go a couple miles on 2818, and turn RIGHT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

→ **Directions to Louis Pearce: From Austin**-- Hwy 21 to Bryan. As you're coming into Bryan, turn RIGHT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Parkway). Stay on 2818 all the way to College Station, and turn LEFT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

→ **Directions to Louis Pearce: From Dallas/Ft. Worth**-- I-35 South to Waco. From Waco, take Hwy 6 south all the way to Bryan. Take the "FM 2818— Bryan Business Park—George Bush Library" exit, and turn RIGHT onto FM 2818 (Harvey Mitchell Parkway). Stay on 2818 all the way to College Station, and turn LEFT onto George Bush Dr. The pavilion will be on the RIGHT about 1/3 mile.

→ **Lodging:** Please inform management of your dogs when making a reservation. Please check with each hotel regarding their current pet policies. There are also LOTS of other hotels in the Bryan/College Station area.

→ **Food:** There are some fast food and dine-in restaurants within 10 minutes of the trial site. We recommend you bring your own food and drinks, but please no glass containers. Blue Baker and several pizza chains will deliver to Louis Pearce Pavilion.

→ **Awards:** Placements ribbons will be awarded to at least fourth place in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances which is a pass/fail class. A purple qualifying ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round in each class.

Any new-to-NADAC dog entries are 50% off!! (If the dog has never done NADAC before)

All day-of show entries will be \$22/run. No package pricing.

Day-of show entries will be allowed, if the entry limit is not met.

- 1.1 As used here 'NADAC' means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members) and NHAG (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), and Texas A&M University, (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
- 1.6 Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$25.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we agree to abide by the rules and Regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by the board of NADAC for this trial.
