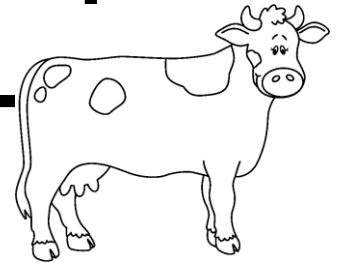
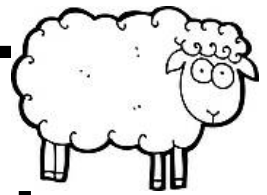
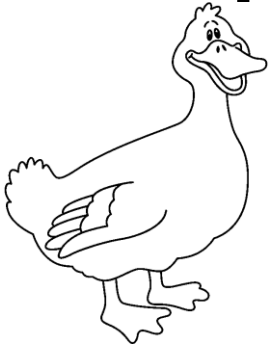

Entries Open February 27, 2017: entries will be accepted by postmark, entries postmarked prior to February 27, 2017 will not be accepted.
Pre-entry closes April 3, 2017. Will accept DAY OF show entry from 7:00am-7:30am each morning of the trials if runs are available.

Saturday Runs – 28 cattle runs, 40 sheep runs, 28 duck runs
Sunday Runs – 28 cattle runs, 40 sheep runs, 28 duck runs

- AM/PM Cattle will run back to back first. AM DUCKS to begin 10 minutes after PM Cattle is complete.
- There will a short break following Cattle to set up Sheep, which will run AM then PM sheep.

Course Director: Donna Doubler

Handlers meeting starts at 7:45 am and trial starts immediately following meeting. Run order will be drawn prior to the trial. Handlers with multiple dogs will be separated as well as possible to allow time to exchange dogs between runs. There will be a set run order and dogs will be expected to run in the assigned order. If a handler has a conflict, they must notify the Course Director ahead of their assigned run time.

Awards:

****Prizes will be awarded each trial for HIT Started, HIT Open, and HIT Advanced. Dog must be entered in two of the stocks to be eligible for these prizes. Weekend Overall Awards will be a belt buckle awarded to HIT Aussie, High in trial other, and Most Promising Started. Dog must be entered in all four trials, all stocks to be eligible for the weekend overall awards. ****

Ribbons will also be given for 1st - 4th place in each class and for qualifying scores.

- ALL ASCA Rules and Regulations will be enforced. All entries must be on an official ASCA entry form. Forms can be downloaded from www.asca.org, go under forms .
- **** No Bitches in season ****
- Individuals will be responsible for any damage done to the stock and/or equipment. Ducks \$35, Sheep \$175.00, and Cattle (market price) replacement cost.
- Entries will not be refunded for any reason after pre-entries close (April 3, 2017). Substitutions of another dog you own will be allowed.
- Please notify the Course Director of move ups as soon as possible.
- Individuals are responsible for any damage done to or by himself, his family, his visitors and his dog, both on the premises and in the trial arena. ASCA, NHASC, Robert & Donna Doubler assume no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- All dogs **MUST** be on leash when not competing. This includes dogs that handlers don't think need leashes.
- Please clean up after your dog.
- All dogs must be crated away from the trialing arenas.

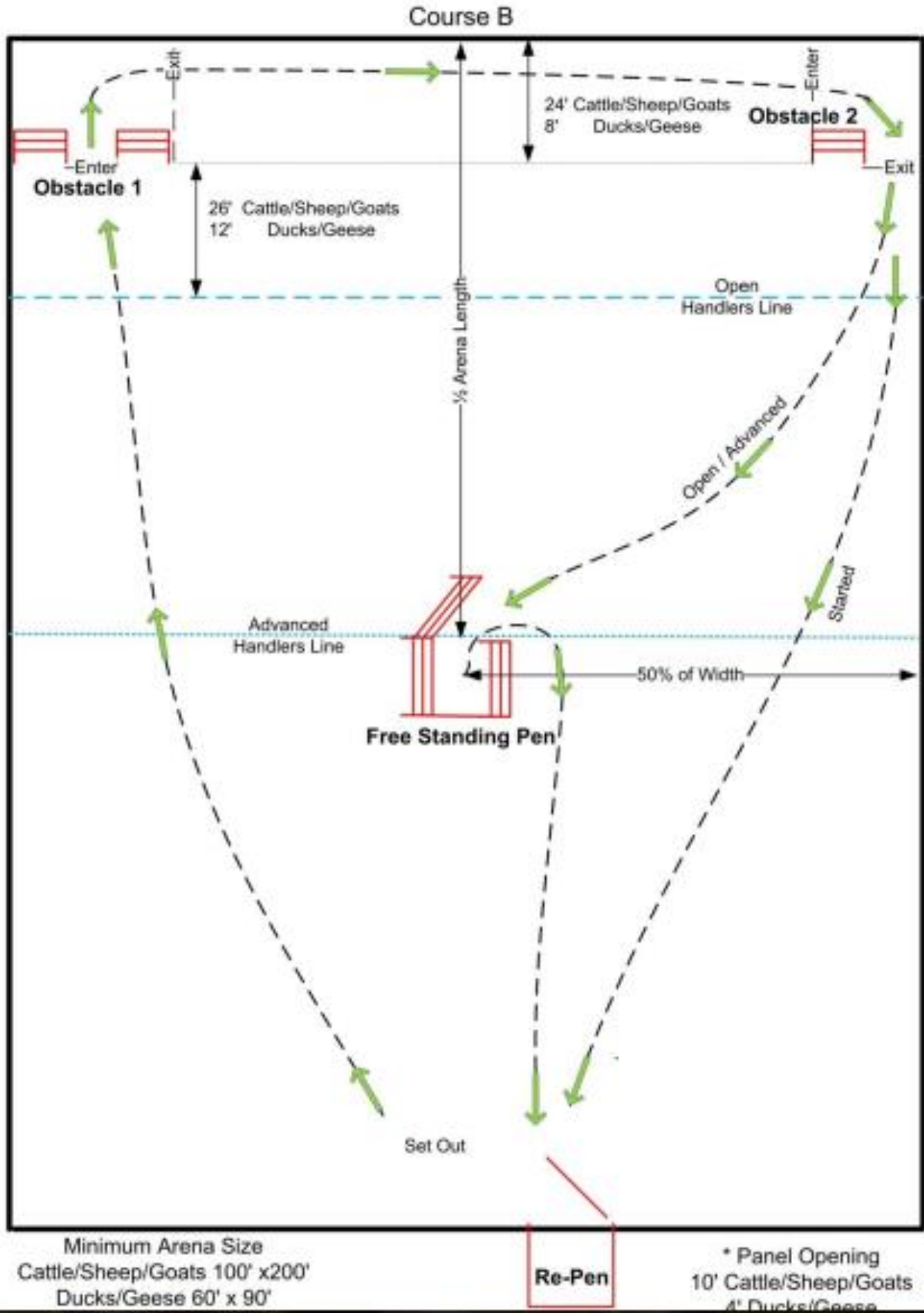

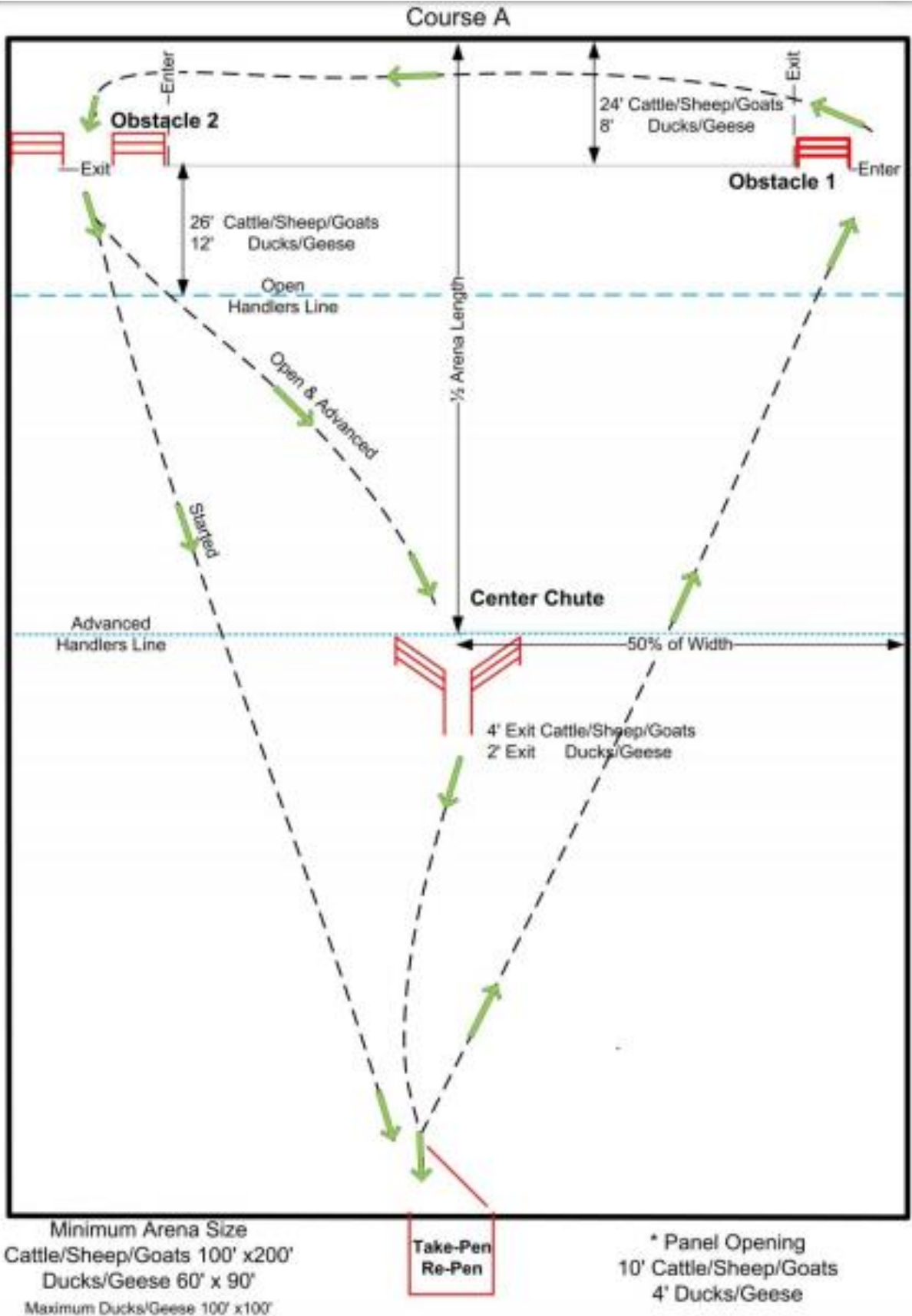
